



Mite Prep

1. The SOURCE of the Mites must be eliminated before a treatment can be done. We do NOT treat birds. Therefore, any pet birds or chickens will need to be treated by a professional vet, moved a good distance away from the home or removed from the property.
 - *Please understand if you keep chickens or birds that are untreated, the chance of a re-infestation is much greater and will not be covered by any warranty.*
2. Clean and vacuum any and all carpets, floors & rugs
3. All sheets, blankets, and other bedding should be washed in detergent and at the hottest water the fabrics can tolerate.
4. Make sure to clear all furniture away from the walls and have the floors clean.
5. Before the treatment is done the homeowner must pick up all loose items on the floor. If this is not done, the technician will not be able to treat your home.
6. Do not leave food or food preparation equipment on surfaces
7. All people & pets are to be away during and after the treatment for at least the required time frame of 2-4 hours.
8. Cover any fish tanks completely with a towel or heavy lid so as to avoid chemicals coming in contact with their environment.
9. Clean areas outside removing pet toys & belongings and children's toys
